TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Daily Rates Include:

- Exclusive use of hunting areas and privacy guaranteed.
- The services of a licensed professional hunter.
- Trackers, skimmers and camp staff.
- Full accommodation and catering.
- Beer and wine in moderation.
- Laundry services.
- Skinning and field preparation of trophies.
- Delivery of trophies to a South African taxidermist and/or shipping company.
- Hunting vehicle and equipment.
- Transport from the nearest International Airport to the lodge and back.
- Transfers between hunting areas.
- Day of arrival and day of departure.
- Hunting licences.
- Meet and greet at Airport.

Daily Rates Do Not Include:

- Trophy fees.
- 14% Value Added Tax payable on Daily Rates only.
- CITES permits where necessary.
- Conservation Trust Levy.
- Gratuities.

Safari Confirmation

- A 50% deposit of the total daily rate is required to confirm a booking. Payment must be made by recognised travelers check or cash. **Personal checks will not be accepted.**
- Zulu Afrika Safaris reserves the right to change any terms, conditions and prices without notice. Rates at the time of the hunt will apply.
- **Due to the extreme fluctuation of exchange rates, all contracted costs (incl. Daily rates, trophy fees & all written costs) are subject to change pending the US\$ to SA Rand currency buying rates of First National Bank, South Africa at the time of part payment or payment in full.**

Note

Trophy fees are payable on all animals killed, or wounded and lost.

Firearms and Ammunition

We recommend that import permits for firearms and ammunition need to be arranged prior to your arrival in South Africa. A temporary import permit will be issued at your port of entry when clearing Customs. The hunting laws require that anyone hunting the "Big Five" will require a minimum calibre of 375. Any calibre from a 270 upwards is suitable for plainsgame hunting. Should you be interested in doing some bird shooting, a 12 gauge shot gun is recommended. Firearms can also be hired by prior arrangement.

Trophy Preparation

Our fully trained staff and skimmers will personally ensure that each of your trophies is prepared, salted and treated with care. Every effort will be made to ensure that the skins are in good condition when delivered to the taxidermist. As part of our service we will deliver the trophies to the export agent or taxidermist as soon as possible after the hunt. A list of recommended South African taxidermists will be made available to you if you choose to have your work done in South Africa.

Safari Duration

We generally recommend a minimum hunting period of 10 - 14 days. The recommended duration of a safari will vary according to your trophy requirements and as a general rule of thumb; we expect to hunt a trophy a day. Some animals are more difficult than others to hunt and therefore require more time to be hunted successfully. A minimum of 14 days is required for a Leopard hunt. The duration of the other "Big Five" safaris will vary according to the area and species to be hunted. All safaris and packages are tailor-made and will be planned on your behalf to fulfil your needs.

Cancellation

Any cancellation will attract a 15% administration fee regardless of the cancellation conditions. If a client cancels their safari in excess of 180 days of the arrival date specified in the contract, 50% of the deposit will be forfeited. If the hunt is cancelled in less than 180 days, no refund will be made unless a replacement hunter can be found. All cancellations will attract a 15% administration fee.

Liability

Whilst all reasonable precautions are taken to ensure the safety and good health of clients, Zulu Afrika Safaris will accept no liability for injury or illness during or after the safari.
